## **RESOLUTION 12-01-89-06**

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH NAYQUONABE TO THE AMERICAN INDIAN ADVISORY COUNCIL ON CHEMICAL DEPENDANCY

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the American Indian Advisory Council requires a resolution from the Mille Lacs Tribal government supporting the appointment of their Tribal representative to the Council; and,
- WHEREAS, each Tribe in Minnesota has a seat on the American Indian Advisory Board; and,
- WHEREAS, Joseph Nayquonabe is employed as the Chemical Dependency Outpatient Counselor for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe on the Council.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians wholeheartedly supports and endorses Joseph Nayquonabe as a member of the American Indian Advisory Council.
- IN THE WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that this resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 7th day of March, 2006 at Isle, Minnesota by a Vote of \_\_3 FOR, \_\_0\_ AGAINST, \_0\_ SILENT.
