RESOLUTION # 12-03-83-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LAND LEASE FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES TO MILLE LACS BAND HOUSING DEPARTMENT (MLBHD)

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and.
- the Mille Lacs Band housing Department respectfully requests a land lease for WHEREAS. Residential purposes: and.
- WHEREAS, the lease will be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and.
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: A Part of Tract Numbers 410 T 1001 and 410 T 1032, located in the Southeast one-quarter of the southeast one-quarter of Section 17, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, further described as:

Whence southeast corner Lot 33, also northeast corner Lot 40, bears north 100 feet of the northeast corner Lot 34, also southeast corner Lot 40, the point of beginning, thence south 100 feet to southeast corner Lot 34, thence west 200 feet to southwest corner Lot 34, thence north 100 feet to northwest corner Lot 34, also southeast corner Lot 40, thence east 200 feet to northeast corner of Lot 34, also southeast corner Lot 40. (Lot 34 is also known as Lot A of the North Vineland Plat Map attached as Exhibit A hereto and incorporated herein by reference.)

the lease rental is \$1.00 and there is a \$2.00 lease processing fee. WHEREAS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes a land lease for the property described herein for residential purposes be issued to the Mille Lacs Band Housing Department for a period of 25 years,

- renewable for an additional 25 years subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the lessee will utilize the land in conformity with the provisions of the lease within twelve (12) months of the effective date of the lease, and if all terms of the lease are not met, the land will revert to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lessee abandon or vacate the above-described property for more than thirty (30) consecutive days after the 1st year anniversary of the effective date of the lease without the prior approval of the Band Assembly; and,
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 2nd of July, 2007 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2</u> FOR, <u>Ø</u> AGAINST, <u>Ø</u> SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
