RESOLUTION 12-04-111-07

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUANCE OF GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS UNTIL OCTOBER 31, 2007.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, Band Assembly Appropriation Bill 11-04-48-05, to fund the operations of the Band Government for fiscal years 2006 and 2007, expires September 30, 2007; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 18 states that in such circumstances, when an appropriation bill will expire before the next such appropriation bill becomes law, the Band Assembly may adopt a continuing resolution to continue any of the Band's fiscal operations; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of all Government operations until October 31, 2007 at 4:30 p.m.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 27th day of September 2007 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of <u>3</u> FOR, <u>O</u>AGAINST, <u>O</u>SILENT.
