A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE'S APPLICATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS' NATIVE LANGUAGE PRESERVATION PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the importance of preserving our Ojibwe language and culture; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the need for this ANA program to help support the preservation of our Ojibwe language and culture.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of an application to the Administration for Native Americans' Native Language Preservation program.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 6th day of March, 2008 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
