## **RESOLUTION 13-02-43-08**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING NEW LICENSE APPLICATIONS FOR OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS FOR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY DISTRICT 2 AND DISTRICT 3.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2 authorizes the Band Assembly to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Mille Lacs Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly acknowledges that a new license is required to expand the Outpatient program to the outer districts in order that billing of Recovery Maintenance Services (formerly known as Aftercare) be permitted; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly agrees that such new licenses are needed and desired under the Chemical Dependency program to expand the Alcohol and Drug program to District II and District III.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Band Assembly hereby acknowledges that new licenses are needed and requests that the same be granted to expand the Outpatient program to the outer districts (District II and District III) in order to bill for the Recovery Maintenance Services (formerly known as Aftercare).
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th day of July, 2008 at Onamia, Minnesota, by a vote of \_3\_FOR, \_\_0\_AGAINST, \_0\_SILENT.
