**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RESUBMISSION OF THE MILLE LACS
BAND OF OJIBWE'S PUBLIC LAW 102-477 PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that P.L. 102-477 allows the consolidation of services and the Band Assembly fully support these goals; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the need for the Band to resubmit a "477 Plan" in order for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe to continue realizing the benefits of P.L. 102-477.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the resubmission of a P.L. 102-477 Plan to the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of January, 2008 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
