**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE MILLE LACS
BAND OF OJIBWE'S 2008-2009 MINNESOTA FAMILY INVESTMENT
PROGRAM BIENNIAL SERVICE AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the importance of the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) and fully supports its goals; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the need for the submission of the MFIP Biennial Service Agreement in order for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe to continue realizing the benefits of MFIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of the MFIP Biennial Service Agreement with the Minnesota Department of Human Services.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of November 2007 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
