RESOLUTION 13-02-56-08

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A NEW MILLE LACS BAND RESERVATION HALF-WAY HOUSE IN DISTRICT I

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2 authorizes the Band Assembly to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Mille Lacs Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly acknowledges that a new Half-way House is needed on the Mille Lacs Band Reservation and that this service is needed to assist Mille Lacs Band Members in their recovery efforts from alcohol and drug addiction; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly further acknowledges that a Mille Lacs Band Half-way House on the reservation would be an asset to the community and would improve the social and economic conditions of Band Members.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Band Assembly hereby supports a new Half-way House on the Mille Lacs Band Reservation in District I and acknowledges that this service is needed to assist Mille Lacs Band Members in their recovery efforts from alcohol and drug addictions.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 30th day of July, 2008 at Vineland, Minnesota, by a vote of <u>3</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
