## JOINT RESOLUTION 13-01-149-08

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT TO THE GROTTO FOUNDATION FOR AN OJIBWE LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive is empowered to exercise the Executive Branch powers of the Band; and

WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and

WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive recognize that an Ojibwe language revitalization program continues to be a priority; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe fully support the application of a grant to the Grotto Foundation for a one-year language revitalization project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Grotto Foundation for a one-year language revitalization project.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 15th day of January, 2008 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
