## **RESOLUTION 13-01-161-08**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE'S APPLICATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS' NATIVE LANGUAGE PRESERVATION PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and
- the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the importance of preserving our WHEREAS, Ojibwe language and culture; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the need for this ANA program to help support the preservation of our Ojibwe language and culture.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of an application to the Administration for Native Americans' Native Language Preservation program.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 6th day of March, 2008 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, O AGAINST, O SILENT.
