RESOLUTION 12-04-124-08

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION #12-02-04-07 FOR  
[REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #12-02-04-07, authorized rescinding resolution #05-03-56-93 and authorized a new lease site be given to [REDACTED] for the purposes of relocation; and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has requested not to be relocated and remain at the lease site legally described in resolution #05-03-56-93.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Rescinding of Band Resolution #12-02-04-07; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that [REDACTED] will remain at the legal description in resolution #05-03-56-93 for the purposes of a residential home site; and

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the land for the new lease site described in resolution 12-02-04-07 will revert to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2007 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
