JOINT RESOLUTION 12-04-134-08

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS DETERMINING THAT IT SHALL NOT USE THE MCT TRIBAL ELECTION COURT OF APPEALS DURING THE NEXT ELECTION CYCLE

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- the Chief Executive of the Band is empowered to exercise the Executive WHEREAS, Branch powers of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is one (1) of the six (6) Chippewa Bands forming the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe ("MCT"); and
- Article III of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Revised Constitution and WHEREAS, Bylaws empower the Tribal Executive Committee ("TEC") as the governing body of the MCT; and
- WHEREAS, the Secretary-Treasurer and the Chief Executive are voting members of the TEC; and
- WHEREAS, the MCT Election Ordinance #10 (Revised 11/02/07), Chapter III, Section 4.B.2. sets forth the jurisdictional limitations of the MCT Tribal Election Court of Appeals and specifically mandates that the "Band governing body will notify the Tribe of its decision as to whether to use the Court before the date established for preparation of the Election Announcement;" and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive have determined that it is in the Band's best interest to follow 5 MLBSA § 111(f) authorizing original jurisdiction over election disputes in the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe's Court of Central Jurisdiction Court of Appeals.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly and Chief Executive have determined that it is in the Mille Lacs Band's best interest that original jurisdiction over election disputes during the next election cycle remain in the Court of Central Jurisdiction.
