## **RESOLUTION 13-02-16-09**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUANCE OF THE GAMING REGULATORY AUTHORITY, HOUSING INITIATIVE AND CORPORATE COMMISSION FISCAL OPERATIONS UNTIL JANUARY 31, 2009.

- the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the WHEREAS. Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless WHEREAS, of source; and
- 3 MLBSA § 18 states that all fiscal operations under the jurisdiction of the Mille WHEREAS, Lacs Band shall cease as of midnight of the last day of the fiscal year, unless the Band Assembly adopts a continuing resolution.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of the Gaming Regulatory Authority, Housing Initiative and Corporate Commission fiscal operations until January 30, 2009.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if any one of these three budgets is formally adopted prior to the January 30, 2009 deadline, the remaining budgets shall remain as approved under this Continuing Resolution.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2008 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly.
