JOINT RESOLUTION 13-03-66-09

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PARTICIPATION AND SUPPORT OF THE INDIAN CRIME AWARENESS "I-CARE" PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the disparity in reporting tribal criminal activity resulting in a lessened ability by the several Indian Tribes to adequately address tribal law enforcement; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe fully supports the goals of various Tribal and State Law Enforcement Services together with Fox Valley Technical College to address the disparity in crime data assessment, collection, and reporting in order to increase the effectiveness of Law Enforcement Services on Indian Reservations, and
- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes this joint effort entitled Indian Crime Awareness, known as "I-Care" which requires a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) from the participating parties which is attached hereto and this Tribal Resolution indicating support by the Tribal Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve a Joint Resolution for support of Indian Crime Awareness I-Care project and authorizes the Chief Executive to execute the attached MOU and forward it together with this Tribal Joint Resolution to the appropriate entities.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing joint resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of April 2009 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.


