JOINT RESOLUTION 14-01-86-10

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN ENDANGERED LANGUAGE FUND GRANT TO THE ENDANGERED LANGUAGE FUND ORGANIZATION TO HELP THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S PRESERVATION OF LANGUAGE PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority the improvement of WHEREAS, the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the importance of preserving the culture of the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe fully supports language preservation projects that seek to document native dialects in an effort to teach future generations their linguistic heritage.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Endangered Language Fund to assist in the preservation and instruction of its native dialects.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 15th day of April, 2010 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
