RESOLUTION 14-01-80-10

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION # 06-03-107-95 AUTHORIZING A RESIDENTIAL LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution #06-03-107-95, authorized a residential land lease to be given to
- WHEREAS, the residential lease was to be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, and is subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval; and
- WHEREAS. said land is described as follows: That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 18, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, of the Forth Principal Meridian, in Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, described as following; Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; thence North 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 seconds West 33.00 feet along the east line of said Northeast quarter of the Southwest Quarter to the point of beginning; thence North 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 seconds West 200.00 feet along said east line; thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 27 seconds West 100.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 seconds East 200.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 58 minutes 27 seconds East 100.00 feet to the point of beginning; and
- WHEREAS, resinding Resolution #06-03-107-95 is being requested by the Lessee due to nonuse of the site; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Rescinding of Band Resolution #06-03-107-95; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land will revert to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
