## RESOLUTION 14-01-78-10

## A RESOLUTION CANCELLING A LEASE AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION # 11-04-116-05 FOR A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe WHEREAS, for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution #11-04-116-05, authorized a lease to be given to for the purpose of residential home site; and
- WHEREAS. the lease was for a period of 35 years plus 15 years renewal, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon September 27, 2005, for the property described herein; and
- said land is described as follows: WHEREAS, Part of Tract 410 T 1001 located in the North one-half (N ½) of the Northeast One-quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Forty-three North (T43N) Range Twenty-seven West, (R27W) Mille Lacs County, Fourth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Lot Thirty-one (31), Bugg Hill Plat. The lease site is approximately 1 acre more or less; and,

- WHEREAS, a Cancellation of the lease authorized by Resolution #11-04-116-05 to is being requested by Lessor due to violation of lease provisions #3, #18 & #19; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the lease cancellation authorized by Resolution #11-04-116-05; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the land will revert to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 25th of March, 2010 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
