JOINT RESOLUTION 14-01-85-10

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE NEW U.S.D.O.J. 2010 "COORDINATED TRIBAL ASSISTANCE **SOLICITATION" GRANT**

- the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes the importance of providing professional referral service, public safety, and victim services; and
- WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe fully supports the goals of the United States Department of Justice in providing tribes the opportunity to apply as a coordinated approach to improving crime prevention and victim services; and
- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes how the Mille Lacs Band's Judicial Branch, Department of Public Safety, and Victim Service departments request funding through this specific grant solicitation to supplement new programs, training, and equipment needs; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (grant) to the Department of Justice for the purpose of obtaining supplemental Federal funding.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 15th day of April, 2010 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 2_FOR, 0_AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
