RESOLUTION 14-01-35-10

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUANCE OF THE GAMING REGULATORY AUTHORITY AND CORPORATE COMMISSION FISCAL OPERATIONS UNTIL MARCH 28, 2010.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 18 states that in such circumstances, when an appropriation bill will expire before the next such appropriation bill becomes law, that all fiscal operations under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band shall ease as of midnight of the last day of the fiscal year unless the Band Assembly adopts a continuing resolution to continue any of the Band's fiscal operations; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of the Gaming Regulatory Authority, and Corporate Commission fiscal operations until March 28, 2010.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of February, 2010 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
