RESOLUTION 14-02-34-11

A RESOLUTION CANCELLING RESOLUTION # 13-02-44-08 & 08-04-92-99 AUTHORIZING A RESIDENTIAL LAND LEASE WITH AN ATTACHED MORTGAGE TO [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home, and
- WHEREAS, Resolution #13-02-44-08 & 08-04-92-99, authorized a land lease for residential purposes to be given to [REDACTED] for establishing his home with financing obtained from the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program; and
- WHEREAS, the residential lease was to be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, and is subject to the lease provisions, effective October 21, 1999; and
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:
Parcel C, from Survey Job # 985859, dated 05-21-1998 and registered in Book 41, Page 7, Central Minnesota Surveying, Inc.

That part of the Northeast Quarter, Section 34, Township 42, Range 26, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the northeast corner of said Northeast Quarter; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds west, assumed bearing, 1527.56 feet along the north line of said Northeast Quarter to the point of beginning of said tract to be described: thence South 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 250.00 feet, thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 200.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 250.00 feet to said north line of the Northeast Quarter; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 200.00 feet along said north line of the Northeast Quarter to the point of beginning. Subject to County Road No. 23 across the north 50 feet thereof.

- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has defaulted on his mortgage and The Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program has put the home on the market to sell.


