#### **JOINT RESOLUTION 16-03-46-15**

## A JOINT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING U.S. BANK TRUST AS A DEPOSITORY FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is empowered by 3 MLBSA § 2(d) to adopt resolutions which promote the general welfare of the people; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive is the duly elected Executive Officer for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe and is empowered to exercise the Executive Branch powers; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has approved the accounts of specifically appropriated funds as shown hereinbelow to U.S. Bank Trust.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that U.S. Bank Trust is designated as a depository for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and

- (1) This resolution shall continue to have effect until express written notice of its rescission or modification has been received and recorded by U.S. Bank Trust.
- (2) The Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer or Commissioner of Finance, so long as they act in a representative capacity as officials of the Mille Lacs Band, are authorized to make any and all other contracts, agreements, stipulations and orders which they may deem advisable for the effective exercise of the powers indicated below, from time to time with U.S. Bank Trust concerning funds deposited in U.S. Bank Trust or any other Business transacted by and between the Mille Lacs Band and U.S. Bank Trust subject to any restrictions stated below.
- (3) Any and all prior resolutions adopted by the Mille Lacs Band and certified to U.S. Bank Trust as governing the operation of the Mille Lacs Band's account(s) are in full force and effect, unless supplemented or modified by this authorization.
- (4) The Mille Lacs Band agrees to the terms and conditions of any account agreement, properly opened by any authorized officials of the Mille Lacs Band, and authorizes U.S. Bank Trust named above, at any time, to charge the Mille Lacs Band for all checks, drafts, or other orders, for the payment of money, that are drawn on this Financial Institution regardless of by whom or by what means the facsimile signature(s) may have been affixed as long as DISTRICT II

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that U.S. Bank Trust may deal with any and all of the persons directly or indirectly as to inquiries and information by the foregoing resolution empowered, as though they were dealing with the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe directly; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary-Treasurer of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe be and hereby is authorized, empowered and directed to certify, under the seal of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, to U.S. Bank Trust: (a) a true copy of this Resolution; (b) specimen signatures of each and every person by this Resolution empowered; and (c) a certificate which, if required by U.S. Bank Trust shall be supported by an opinion of legal counsel of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, or other counsel satisfactory to U.S. Bank Trust that the Band is duly organized and existing, that its statutes empower it to transact the business by this Resolution, and that no limitation has been imposed upon such powers by the laws of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe or otherwise; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that U.S. Bank Trust may rely upon the certified copy of the resolutions, specimen signatures, and certificate, as continuing fully effective unless and until U.S. Bank Trust shall receive written notice of change or rescission, and the dispatch or receipt of any other form of notice shall not constitute a waiver of this provision, nor shall the fact that any person hereby empowered ceases to be an officer of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe or becomes an officer under some other title, in any way affect the powers hereby conferred, but the failure to supply a specimen signature shall not invalidate any transaction where the party authorizing the same has been actually empowered thereto by or in conformity with these resolutions; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the **Investment account** shall be a Cash Account for the purpose of purchasing, selling, transferring, exchanging and generally dealing in any and all forms of securities and financial instruments of every kind or nature whatsoever. All orders and instructions, written or oral, relating to the

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> Securities Accounts shall be given to U.S. Bank Trust by three of the individuals designated under the heading "Authorized Individuals," and to have three individuals hereby authorized and directed to purchase and/or sell and/or deal in any and all securities and financial instruments for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, including the power to deliver, accept delivery of, endorse, and direct the transfer of record title of any account assets beneficially owned by the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, without obligation to inquire into the reasons for said orders or instructions; and

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event of any change in the office or powers of persons hereby empowered, the Secretary-Treasurer shall certify such changes to U.S. Bank Trust in writing in the manner herein above provided, which notification, when received, shall be adequate both to terminate the powers of the persons theretofore authorized, and to empower the persons thereby substituted; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Executive, Secretary-Treasurer, District Representatives and the Commissioner of Finance of the Mille Lacs Band of Oilbwe be, and hereby are, authorized and empowered to countersign items as aforesaid: and
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that this resolution and the certificates actually furnished to U.S. Bank Trust by the Secretary-Treasurer of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe pursuant thereto, be and they hereby are made irrevocable until written notice of the revocation thereof shall have been received by U.S. Bank Trust.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th day of March, 2015 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of \_3 FOR, O AGAINST, O SILENT.
