

JOINT RESOLUTION 16-03-35-15

A JOINT RESOLUTION DENYING THE ENROLLMENT INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT MEET THE 1/4 DEGREE REQUIREMENT OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the following applications for enrollment; and

do not meet the requirements for enrollment into the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed Article II-Membership of the Revised Constitution and By-laws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly denies the above applications for enrollment because they do not meet the requirements found in Article II of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Constitution.
