## **RESOLUTION 17-02-124-16**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A NEW TRANSITIONAL HOUSING POLICY

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band") a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, according to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly is empowered to adopt résolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, suitable housing is an ongoing need of Band members, both on a permanent and transitional basis; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly wishes to promote housing policies that are uniquely designed to the needs of Band members.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Band Assembly hereby authorizes and approves passage of the attached Transitional Housing Policy.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016, at Hinckley, Minnesota, by a vote of 3 FOR, 6 AGAINST, SILENT.
