JOINT RESOLUTION 16-04-113-15

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN OJIBWE LANGUAGE REVILAIZATION GRANT TO THE MINNESOTA INDIAN AFFAIRS COUNCIL TO HELP FUND THE GE-NIIGAANIZIJIG (ONE'S THAT WILL LEAD) INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, according to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly is empowered to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive of the Band is empowered to exercise the Executive Branch powers of the Band; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive have established as a priority the improvement of the spiritual, physical, mental, social, and economic well-being of the people of the Mille Lacs Band; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive fully support the mission statement of the Minnesota Indian Affairs Council "Dakota and Ojibwe are spoken and valued as vibrant, living and thriving languages throughout Minnesota" as well as their vision "To protect and empower our children, parents, and elders in the continuing revitalization of our language, thus maintaining Tribal Sovereignty'.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive do hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Minnesota Indian Affairs Council for the purposes of protecting and developing our language through preservation and education.
