JOINT RESOLUTION 17-03-53-17

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF MILLE LACS BAND TRIBAL POLICE CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY SEAT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band"), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly has the power to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 4 MLBSA § 2, the Chief Executive is empowered to exercise the Executive Branch powers of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive have established as a priority the improvement of the spiritual, physical, mental, social, and economic well-being of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive fully support the Bureau of Indian Affairs Indian Highway Safety Program FY2017 Child Passenger Safety Seat Program grant to reduce the high number of traffic crashes and their resulting fatalities, injuries and property damage within Indian countries; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive recognize that this is a reimbursement grant and there is no cost match for the Band.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Band Assembly and Chief Executive do hereby authorize and approve the submission of the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Police Child Passenger Safety Seat Program submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
