RESOLUTION 17-02-19-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MILLE LACS CORPORATE VENTURES TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM 2017 CAPITAL BUDGET FOR GRAND CASINO HINCKLEY WALK-IN COOLER

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band"), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is authorized under 3 MLBSA sec. 2(b) to appropriate all Band revenue regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is also authorized under 3 MLBSA sec. 2(d) to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs formally requested approval on November 28, 2016 to expend 2017 capital project funds for Grand Casino Hinckley Walk-in Cooler in the amount of \$603,500.00
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Mille Lacs Corporate Ventures expenditure listed hereinabove from the 2017 Capital Budget.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of December, 2016 at Nayahshing, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, o AGAINST, o SILENT.
