RESOLUTION 18-04-119-19

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE MILLE LACS EARLY EDUCATION AND AANJIBIMAADIZING TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band"), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly is empowered to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band has established as a priority the improvement of spiritual, physical, mental, social and economic wellbeing of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, one of the Band's goals is to make childcare more accessible for Mille Lacs Band Members; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Early Education program ("MLEE") provides child care services for the Band's children; and
- WHEREAS, the MLEE receives federal grant funds to support child care under the Child Care Development Funds grant ("CCDF"); and
- WHEREAS, the AanjiBimaadizing Program is able to supplement the CCDF by providing addition funding to MLEE to cover staff salaries, training, supplies and equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the AanjiBimaadizing Program and MLEE wish to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding in which the AanjiBimaadizing Program will provide MLEE with the afore mentioned funding in order to provide additional childcare services in Districts 2, and 3.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly hereby supports the Memorandum of Understanding between the AanjiBimaadizing Program and Mille Lacs Early Education.
