## **JOINT RESOLUTION 18-02-16-19**

A JOINT RESOLUTION AMENDING JOINT RESOLUTION 18-02-177-18: APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A TRIBAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT GRANT TO THE UNITED STATES ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES: OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT FOR FY2019

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band") a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly is empowered to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 4 MLBSA § 2, the Chief Executive of the Band is empowered to exercise the Executive Branch powers of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive have established as a priority the improvement of spiritual, physical, mental, social and economic well-being of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive recognize the importance and purpose of the established Child Support Enforcement for adequate support and nurturing of the children under the jurisdiction of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive fully support the goals of the Office of Child Support Enforcement; and
- WHEREAS, on July 26, 2018, Band Assembly approved Joint Resolution 18-02-177-18 supporting the commitment of cost sharing monies or in-kind resources in order to receive funding in the amount of \$732,792.13 of which \$147,814.65 or 20% is the required match; and
- WHEREAS, the Band was later informed that the funding proposal increased by \$113.42, which also increased the 20% match thereby necessitating an amendment to Joint Resolution 18-02-177-18; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive now recognize that the Band is required to commit cost sharing monies or in-kind resources in order to receive funding in the increased amount of \$739,640.38 of which \$147,928.07 or 20% is the required match.
