RESOLUTION 18-03-57-19

**A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL A RESIDENTIAL LEASE AUTHORIZED
BY RESOLUTION 05-02-82-92 FOR MILLE LACS BAND MEMBER**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (“Band Assembly”) is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe (“Band”), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2 (d), the Band Assembly has the power to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Band for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-02-82-92 authorized a land lease for residential purposes to Band Member [REDACTED] for the purpose of obtaining a lease site; and

WHEREAS, the land lease was to be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract 410T001032A, all that part of Government Lot Two (2), Section Seventeen (17), Township Forty-three (43), Range Twenty-seven (27), Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, Fourth Principle Meridian. More particularly described as follows:

Parcel B:

Commencing at a Brass Cap monument at the Southeast corner of said Government Lot 2; thence North 89 degrees 55 minutes 10 seconds West, assumed bearing along the south line of said Government Lot 2, a distance of 751.97 feet; thence North 1 degree 51 minutes 57 seconds West a distance of 553.52 feet to a point on the southerly line of County State Aid Highway No. 35; thence North 88 degrees 08 minutes 03 seconds East, along said southerly line, a distance of 100.00 feet to the point of beginning of the lot to be described; thence continuing North 88 degrees 08 minutes 03 seconds East, along said southerly line, a distance of 100.00 feet;

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thence South 1 degree 51 minutes 57 seconds East a distance of 200.00 feet; thence South 88 degrees 08 minutes 03 seconds West a distance of 100.00 feet; thence North 1 degree 51 minutes 57 seconds West a distance of 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the lease is being cancelled because Lessee died on January 10, 2010. The Lease should be cancelled so that it can be transferred to the heir.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Band Assembly hereby approves the cancellation of Resolution 05-02-82-92; and

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that the lease site will revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 2nd day of April, 2019 at Aazhoomog, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
