JOINT RESOLUTION 19-01-111-20

A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES – OFFICE OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR THE COVID 19 SUPPLEMENTAL AND BASE INCREASE COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT

- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is the duly-elected legislative body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band"), a federally-recognized Indian tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2(d), the Band Assembly has the power to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 4 MLBSA § 2, the Chief Executive is empowered to exercise the authority of the Executive Branch of government; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive have established as a priority the improvement of spiritual, physical, mental, social and economic wellbeing of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive fully support the MLBO Ge-niigaanizijig Program in providing services to the Band's youth in need; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive support the goals of the Minnesota DHS

 Office of Economic Opportunity to provide funding for direct services to communities and youth in order to enhance child outcomes; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive support the submission of an application, by the Ge-niigaanizijig Program, for the COVID-19 Supplement and Base Increase Community Services Block Grant for the purpose of obtaining state funding to enhance and supplement the current operations of the program to better serve youth in the community; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly and Chief Executive recognize that there are no cost sharing requirements with the submission.
