RESOLUTION 19-02-02-21

A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL RESOLUTION 15-02-163-12 FOR MILLE LACS BAND MEMBER AND MILLE LACS BAND MEMBER

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") is the duly-elected legislative body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe ("Band"), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA § 2 (d), the Band Assembly has the power to adopt resolutions to promote the general welfare of the people of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Band for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution 15-02-163-12 authorized a residential land lease to Band Member and Band Member for the purpose of obtaining a lease site; and
- the land lease was to be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 WHEREAS, years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract #410TF000082, described as Lot Four (4), Block One (1), Port Mille Lacs, Golf Links Addition. Fourth Principle Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota. This lease site is 1 acre, more or less.

- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Band Member passed away on November 1, 2017 and wishes to relinquish and transfer the home Mille Lacs Band Member and personal property to an heir.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Band Assembly hereby approves the cancellation of Resolution 15-02-163-12; and
