SECRETARIAL ORDER 020-- 86

A SECRETARIAL ORDER INVOKING THE PERCENTAGE SHARES OF THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE COST AT THE NAY AH SHING SCHOOL BUILDING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 6, the Secretary of Treasury shall superintend and manage the fiscal concerns as required under Article V, Section 1 of the Revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;

WHEREAS, the Headstart, Nay Shing School and Bingo utilize the school building for various activities, and;

WHEREAS, the Headstart, Nay Shing School and Bingo have not come to terms on the payment of utilities and expenses incurred to such building.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 6 and the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Constitution, I, Douglas Sam, Secretary Treasurer, do hereby declare that in lieu of a signed contractual agreement between Headstart, Nay Ah Shing School and Bingo on expenses of the Operation and Maintenance, that these parties pay 33 1/3% of all Operation and Maintenance bills.

BE IT FINALLY ORDERED, that all Operation and Maintenance billings be billed proportionately to the concerned parties herein stated.
