To Interested Mille Lacs Band Members:

I am seeking out Band members who are interested in serving as the Band Member Representative on the newly created Investment Committee. The selected Band member will serve alongside myself, the Chief Executive, the Commissioner of Finance, and between three and five investment professionals. This is an exciting opportunity for any Band member with a financial background who is interested to learn from outside professionals while making a positive impact on the Band for many years to come.

According to 17 MLBS § 204(f)(1), the Band Member Representative must:

- (1) Be nominated by the Secretary-Treasurer;
- (2) Possess a Master of Finance or Business Administration Degree, *or have other appropriate investment or financial background* (emphasis added); and
- (3) Be confirmed by a majority vote of the Band Assembly.

The term for the Band Member Representative position begins on January 1, 2022, and ends on December 31, 2025. Duties include assisting in the development of the Investment Committee's bylaws, assisting in the revision of the Band's Investment Policy Statement, and making crucial decisions that affect the Band's investment accounts. All other duties of the Investment Committee are outlined in 17 MLBS § 201-211.
