#### Work Scope:

The scope of the work encompasses two wells in the Apple Orchard Community which is located 5 miles south of McGregor, MN. For each well:

- 1. Remove and replace the existing drop pipe with 2" SCH 80 PVC;
- 2. Remove, inspect and reinstall the well pump and motor;
- 3. Test pump for a minimum of two (2) hours;
- 4. Inspect through CCTV.
- 5. Perform chemical and bacteriological analyses.
- 6. Well inspection deliverables include:
  - Static and pumping water level measurements
  - Well Drawdown
  - Pump electrical test results including Meg/Ohms, voltage, amperage, winding resistance, insulation resistance and pump bowl/TDH condition
  - Production rate of wells
  - Video from televising each well
  - Results of water quality analyses
  - Recommended actions based on the well investigation with a cost estimate

#### **Bidding Notes:**

#### Your proposals shall include the following:

- 1. Bid should show a fixed fee to do the above mentioned work schedule. Bid <u>must be signed</u> by contractor to be valid.
- 2. Copy of current MLB Vendor's License. (or a copy of submitted application)
- 3. Copy of current certificate of insurance for General Liability and Property Damage.
- 4. Copy of an authorized signature sheet if one is not already on file with the Mille Lacs Band.
- 5. Federal Davis Bacon wage scale applies to this project.
- 6. Plans and Specifications can be obtained by contacting Brian Scheinost, Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Public Works Department at (320) 532-7437.
- 7. Prime Contractor needs to perform at least 33.3% of the work.
- 8. Compliance with the EEO executive order 11246 as amended, compliance with the Copeland anti-kickback act and compliance with the sections 103 and 107 of the contract work hours and safety standards act.
